Product Description

A highly economical black acrylic lacquer formulated specifically for wood plank fences in the equine industry. This product dries to an extremely tough and durable semi-gloss finish that will not chalk, peel or rub off. Can be applied over virtually any type of marginally prepared, painted or unpainted, surface with excellent results. This product is lead-free and safe around valuable livestock. Also makes an economical coating for barns, sheds, silos and metal or concrete buildings. It is not recommended for interior applications.

Coverage

BARNS - 200 to 300 square feet per gallon on smooth surfaces

FENCES - 16 running feet of 3 or 4 board fence (1 panel both sides) per gallon,

New, extremely rough cut and/or weathered surfaces will take more product and may require two coats for best results. Less than recommended coverage rates will see a reduction in durability.

Dry Time

Product dries overnight by solvent evaporation only but may remain slightly tacky for several days depending on surface painted and amount of material applied. On metal or non-porous surfaces dry time may be longer.

Application

Mix paint thoroughly before application. No thinning is recommended. Make sure fence or barn to be painted is free of mud, dirt and loose or peeling paint. Use scrapers and wire brushes to remove as much as possible. In severe cases pressure washing is recommended. Allow new lumber to weather 1-2 months to reduce the moisture content. This product can be applied with brushes, rollers or spray at any temperature (even below freezing) with excellent results. Always avoid breathing vapor and spray mist and use protective clothing and eve protection.

Spray Equipment

- Minimum recommended pump rating -2/3 gallons per minute. (Graco GM-3000/GMax 3900 or equivalent)
- * Filter 10 mesh suction strainer, 30 mesh pump filter * Tip - .019" to .023" with a 6" pattern for wood plank fence
- or a 10" to 12" pattern for barns. Reversible type tip recommended
- * Clean up with lacquer thinner.
